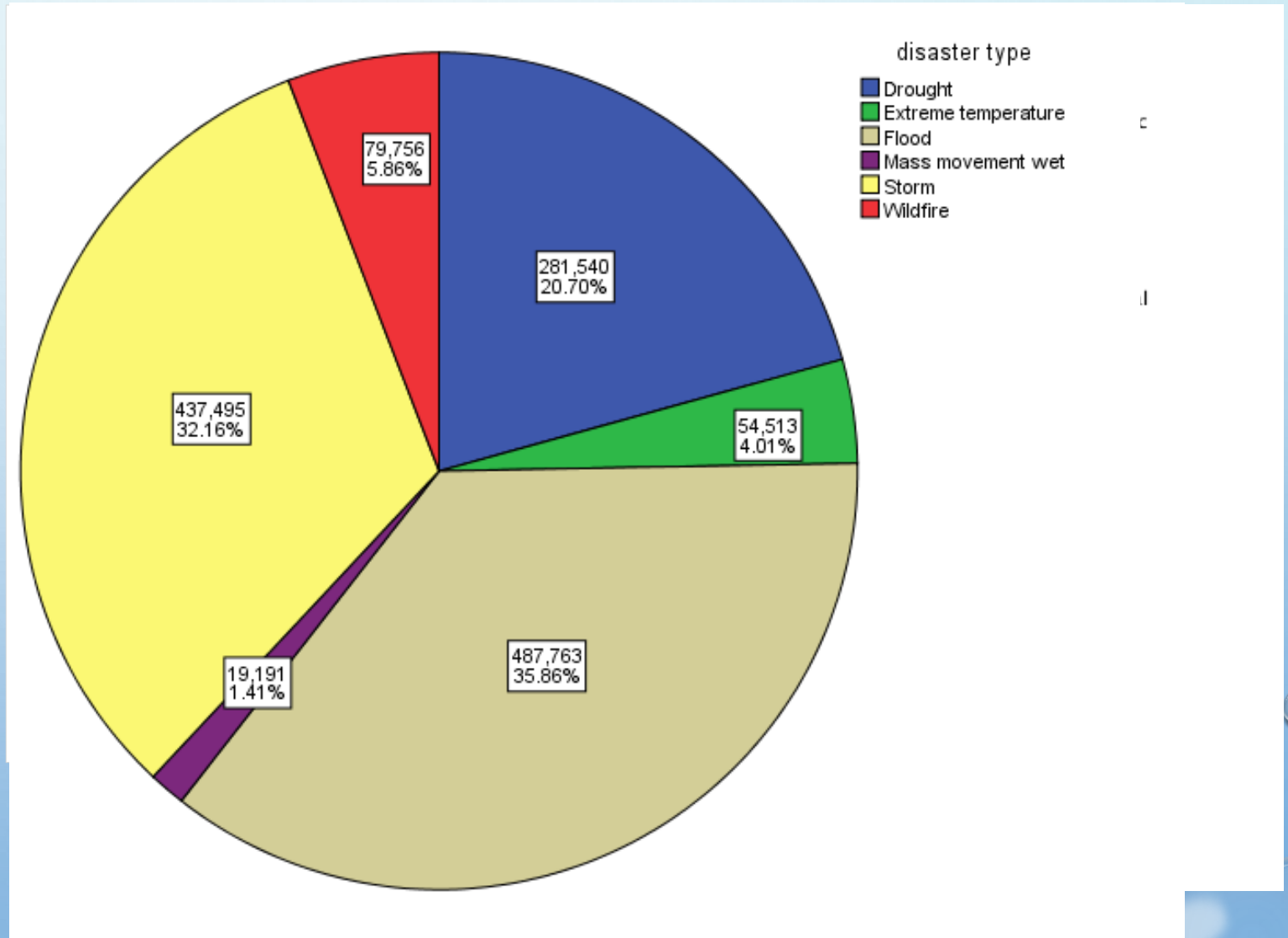

# Why water is missing in the global politics related to climate change and environment?

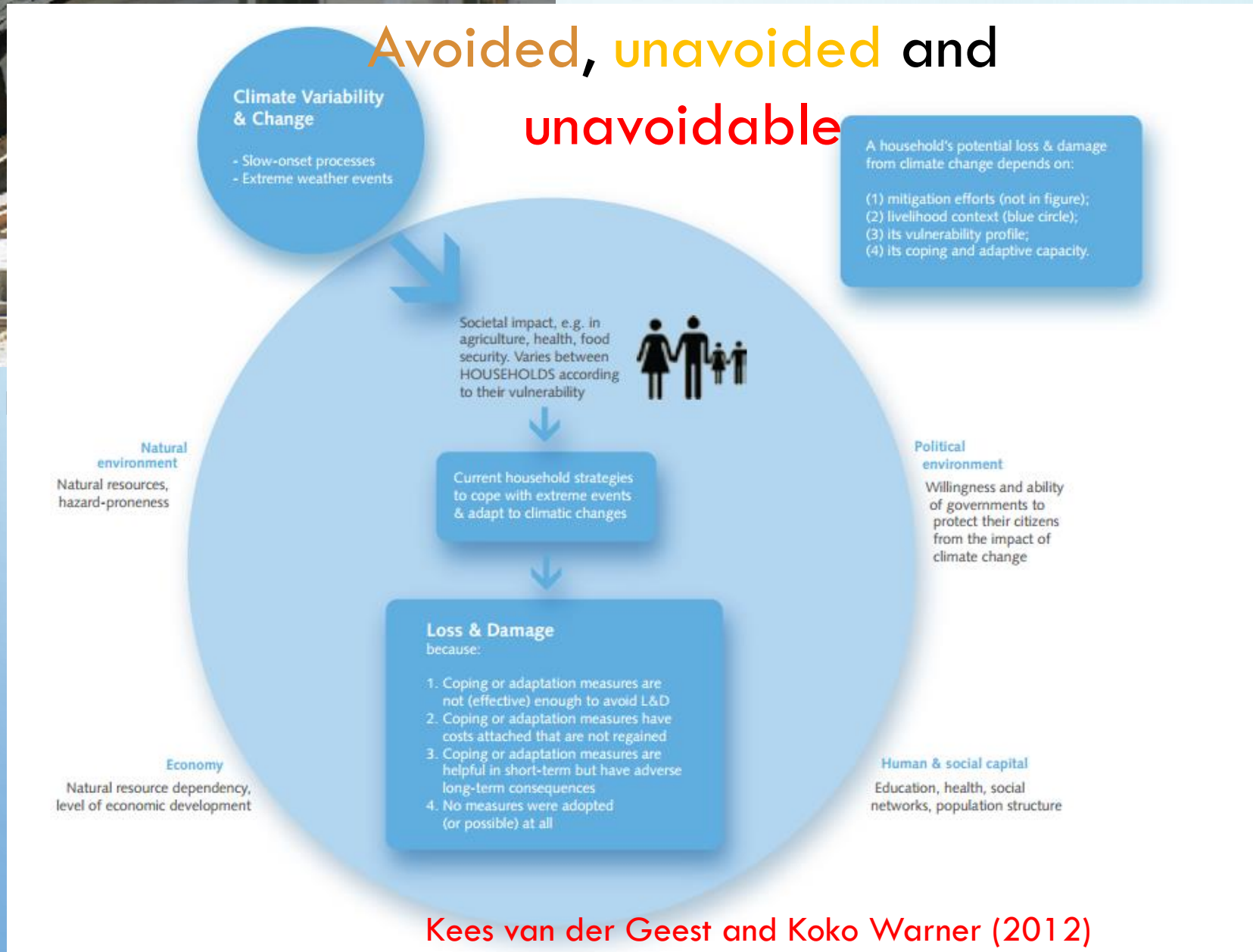

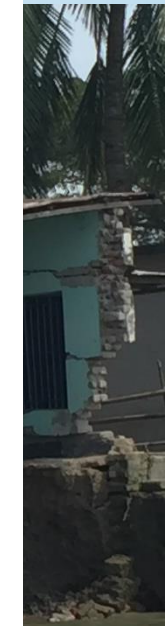

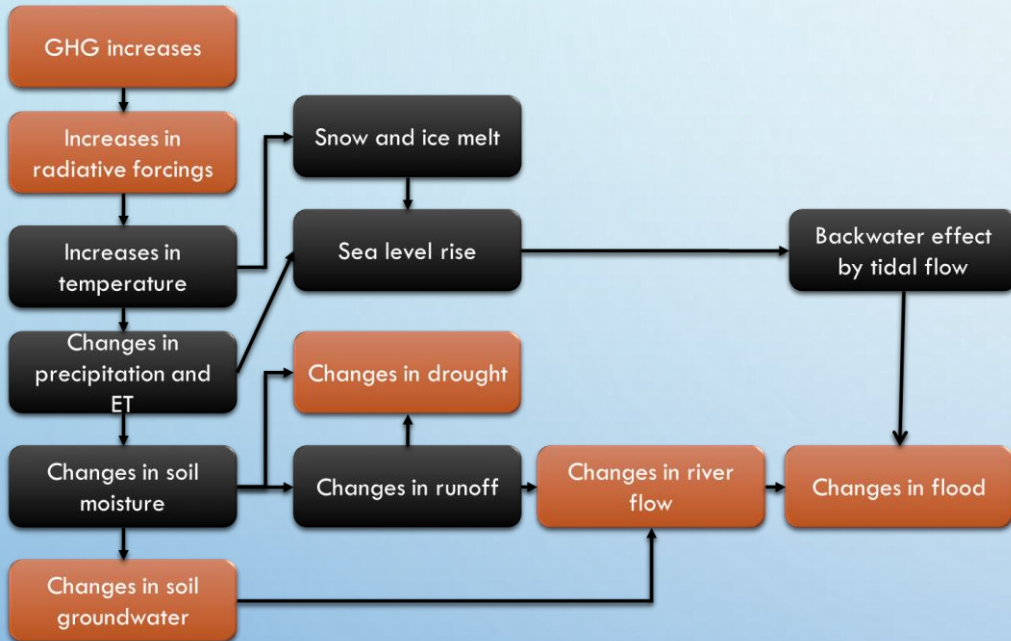

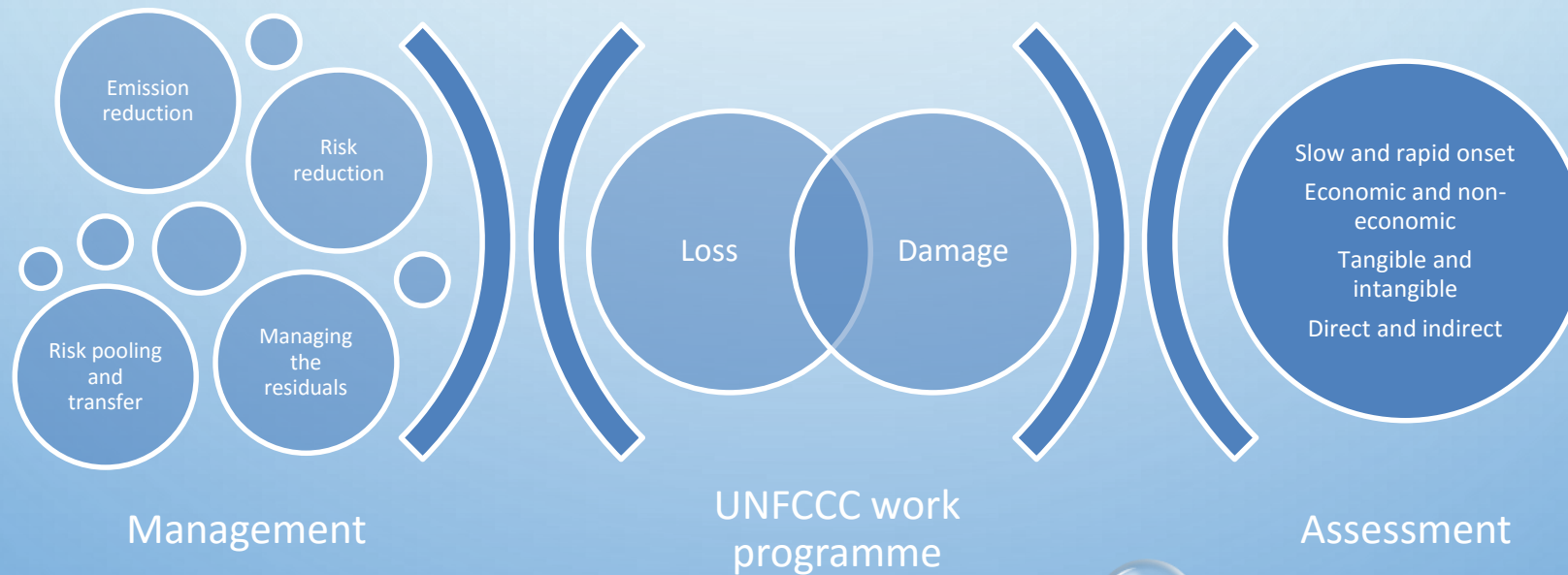
